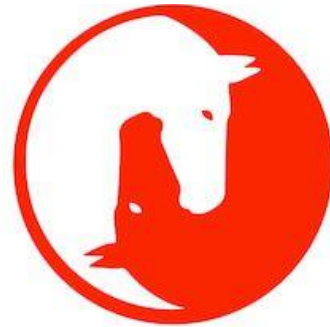

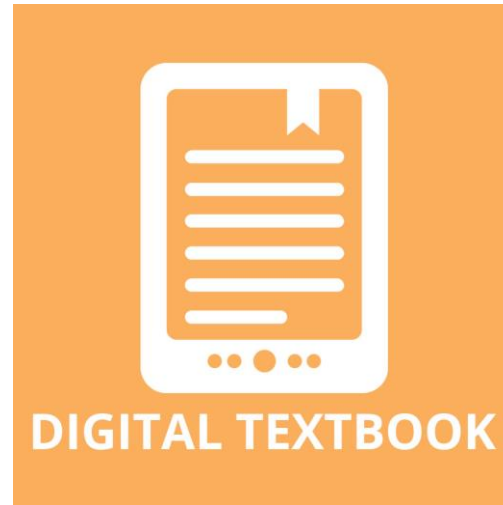

Parking

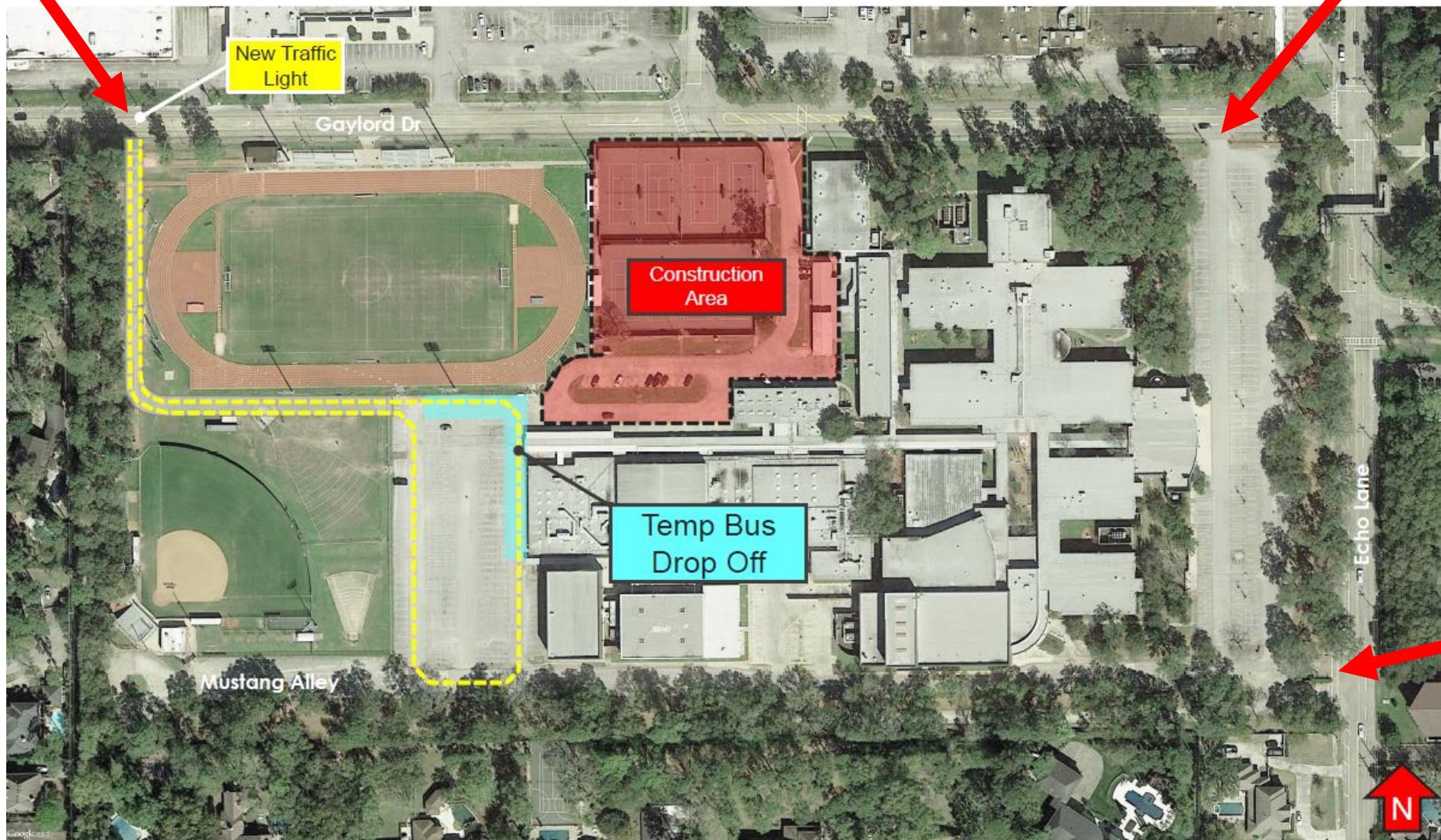
- Visitor parking is located in front of the school
