2022-23 PARKING INFORMATION

Parking is limited! A student's grade level determines what kind of parking is available.

SENIORS – All Seniors are eligible to purchase a permit, which will give them non-assigned parking in the front, back and field house lots.

JUNIORS - Juniors who are selected from the lottery held at the end of their sophomore year are eligible to purchase a permit. This will allow them non-assigned parking in the red spaces located at the back of the church lot. Lottery spots will not be saved if the student does not want to purchase a permit when their name is selected.

SOPHOMORES – Sophomores are not permitted to park on campus unless they have purchased a Spirit permit from the PTA or Booster Club. A lottery will be held at the end of their sophomore year to determine which students will be eligible to park at the church for their junior year. If you do not enter the lottery as a sophomore, you will not be eligible to park on campus as a junior.

FRESHMEN – Freshmen are not permitted to park on campus.

SPIRIT SPOTS

Spirit spots can be purchased for the year from either the Booster Club or PTA for any fully licensed MHS student, regardless of grade level. Watch the PTA newsletter, PTA (mhspta.com) and Booster Club (memorialboosterclub.com) websites for more information. 24/7 assigned parking is available to any student, regardless of their grade level. Auction prices vary.

PTA will raffle one spirit spot in April or May – ticket prices vary but are usually less than \$25.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

Students must also be eligible to purchase a permit:

- Must be in good standing – no overdue fines, fees, or lost textbooks/Chromebook
- Seniors must have submitted Resume, Student Brag Sheet and Parent Brag Sheet on Naviance or to their Counselor
- Must have a valid Texas Driver's License – not expired, not a Learner's Permit.
- Must have valid Texas Insurance – not expired, student must be listed as a driver, car on MHS application must be on insurance policy.

HOW TO APPLY
